Activities Undertaken

TARAPUR SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY (TSDS):

A group consisting of individuals with a view towards seeing a better environment, got together to build a platform of materializing their dream to uplift the mass living below poverty level. That group consisting of social activists from West Bengal set their foot forward and kept on marching till such time the dream turned true in the year 2001. Today eradication of illiteracy has given way to individuals, both men and women, showing signs of literacy in comparison to what it looked like two decades ago.

Achievements of Tarapur Social Development Society in the last 22 years

Promotion of Self Help Group (SHG):

During this period of 22 years, 6520 'Self Help Groups' were promoted with 69,342 women members. Livelihood programs undertaken were Poultry Farming-650 people, Hand Embroidery-750 people, preparation of Phenyle-526 people, Mushroom Cultivation-417 people, Cow Rearing-612 people, Incense Sticks-700 people. All these SHG members' individual earning shows Rs. 5,000/- on an average per month. Some of these participants have employed 2/3 personnel in their respective units.



E-Shakti Project: From 2015 Tarapur Social Development Society (TSDS) has digitized 4681 SHGs with the membership of 49020 under E-Shakti project in 6 blocks of Pashchim Midnapur in collaboration with NABARD. Our staffs conduct day to day monitoring on these SHG activities and update account data in the E-Shakti portal. TSDS is in liaison with 46 bank branches with the aim of advocacy. This is to make it easy for the SHG members to continue with their activities with the help of bank loan.



Crèche: 25 children ranging from 0-6 years are provided with pre-primary education, health & hygiene and supplementary nutritious food in Rampurhat from November 2007.



Relief for COVID 19: Awareness was raised for the precaution of COVID 19 and vaccination thereafter. Relief reached 2200 people when COVID 19 struck, through 'Food Distribution,' 'Mask Distribution' and 'Sanitizer Distribution' at no cost.



Health Care and Nutrition Program: Medical assistance with medicines was provided by a mobile unit of trained health workers. Referral services to the nearest hospital, was provided too. More than 11000 numbers of referral candidates are recorded. Children gained a lot through this nutrition program through packages containing nutritious food. 46 'Health and Nutrition Camps' were organized by TSDS at different parts of West Bengal during the 22 years. Nearly 100000 beneficiaries were reported.





Integrated Agriculture Development Program and Farmers' Club Program: Farmers were educated on the application of farming through modern technology duly supported by NABARD in the districts of Birbhum, Paschim Midnapur and Purulia, in West Bengal. 65 training programs with 3863 participants had been organized with the introduction of modern agriculture and organic farming. TSDS also promoted and nurtured 53 Farmers Club (Purulia - 41 & Birbhum -12) in our operating area.

Vocational and Skill Development Program: TSDS is running 4 skill development successful training centers at 4 districts of West Bengal. 5355 participants had gone through the training course on the art of 'Kantha Stitch, Tailoring, Mask Stitching and Beautician.' 2635 participants out of 5355 had setup a unit of their own. Their earning shows Rs. 5,000/- on an average per month.



Yoga Camp : TSDS organized yoga camps and celebrated International Day of Yoga for the last 6 years in different parts of West Bengal. More than 12,400 common people participated in our program. Our yoga team created the need of the practice of yoga for good health.

Computer Training : During the last 10 years, 2363 students received training on computer skills on different courses from our centre. 735 students out of 2363 students received training totally free of cost.
